

Abortion Expansion in New York State

On Thursday, May 9th, from 7-9pm, St. Bernard’s School of Theology and Ministry will host a panel discussion titled, Abortion Expansion in New York State: Working Toward a Local Catholic Response. It will seek to provide an evening of community and respectful discussion in wake of the recent Reproductive Health Act, with a view towards education and an emphasis on local action.

After a brief informational explanation of the Reproductive Health Act, a panel of local Catholic leaders in health care and medical ethics will discuss the legislation, its implications, and how we can build up a culture of life in Rochester. The evening will begin with a reception and conclude with a Q&A session with all participants.
