Needed Most .... the greatest tool ever - PRAYERS!

Dear parishioners of Holy Apostles Parish,

As I mentioned to you previously, the Pastoral Council, the Staff and many of our ministries and committees at Holy Apostles have been asking how we can be attracting more people to our parish. One of the ideas that surfaced was that we need to have a new sign in front of our church building. We have done a lot of research into this idea and have come up with a sign that meets our needs, as well as the funds for it. The only thing that is necessary is to get approval from the City of Rochester. To do this, we need to go before the City Zoning Board of Appeals... This meeting is scheduled for June 20th.

- The first thing that I would ask you to do, is to please pray for this meeting and the members of the Zoning Board of Appeals, that they would see the merits of what we are trying to do and give approval for the new sign. Secondly, I would ask you to please consider emailing the Zoning Board of Appeals to give a positive comment regarding this, since public testimony is welcomed. In your email, I would ask you to consider including the following information:
- You are a parishioner of Holy Apostles parish (and if you live in the neighborhood, please include that too!)
- The parish has been serving the neighborhood for 135 years and is still actively serving it today for example, through Neighborhood Dinners; a Reading, Music and Dance Camp for children; Cooking Classes for the women of our neighborhood; a Christmas Blessing Project touching the lives of hundreds of children; Ice Cream Socials attracting hundreds of people each summer; the opening of Our Angel Clothing Closet each week; the baking of 500-600 homemade loaves of bread for our neighbors at Easter; Helping countless people falling through the cracks with their needs for shelter and heat and other basic necessities....
- A new sign would help us to be able to advertise these services, as well as parish activities that would be positively beneficial to our neighbors.
- We keep our property as beautifully as we can, and we have space for the sign.
- Because there are 15,509 vehicles on average that pass our church each day, we believe that that many others could benefit from what we offer, if they only knew about it. Our present sign is completely inadequate and unable to accommodate what we would like to communicate. Our parish and neighborhood contain both English-speaking and Spanish-speaking people. A new sign would enable us to communicate in both languages.
- Given the nature of our neighborhood, a sign would not change its essential character... Other similar signs in front of churches have been approved by the Zoning Board of Appeals within the past year, whose neighborhoods were more residential than ours.
- Thank you so much for your willingness to email or write the Zoning Board of Appeals in this regard... When you write to them please refer to the number which has been assigned to our case which is: File # V-076-18-19
