***Our Journey in prayer - Today's Reflection***

Prayer is the most effective means at our disposal for the cleansing of our mind and emotions, because it places the mind in God's bright light and the emotions in his warm love. Prayer is like water that makes Plants grow and extinguishes fires.

Best of all is silent, inward prayer, especially if it reflects upon our Lord's loving sacrifice. If you think of him frequently, he will occupy your soul. You will catch on to his manner of living and thinking. You will begin to live and think like him, the way children learn to talk by listening to their mothers and then making sounds with their own voices.

There is no other way. Prayer is essential. Find an hour each day, in the morning if possible, and pray.

Start every prayer in the presence of God. Be strict about this, and you will soon see its value. Don't rush through your prayers. The Lord's Prayer said once with comprehension is better than many prayers said in haste.

If you can do it, inward, silent prayer is best. If you are reciting a standard prayer and find your heart being drawn deeper, by all means leave the spoken prayer behind and move into silence. Don't worry about leaving your formal prayer unfinished. Your silent prayer pleases God the most, and it will be better for your soul.

Be diligent about this. Don't let a morning pass without some time in silent prayer. But if the demands of business or some other responsibility prevents it, then be sure to repair the damage that evening. Make a vow to start your regular practice of morning pray again tomorrow.
